



## PHYSICAL ACTIVITY GRANT ANNOUNCEMENT

Chatham County Partnership for Children, with funding from the annual Reindeer Run 5K, is pleased to offer grants to promote physical activity in Chatham County. Projects may be located in schools, child care facilities, public areas, parks, churches or worksites. Priority will be given to small scale (less than \$2000) projects that are ***innovative and promote healthy physical activity for underserved groups***. Second priority will be given to proposals that increase access to physical activity by being located in a geographically remote location.
