Purpose

To promote quality child care through educating families about child care. This position is devoted to providing parents with consumer education and referrals through the Child Care Search 5-county call center.

Essential Responsibilities

- 1. Educate parents on child care options, indicators of quality child care, child care regulations, and child development
- 2. Provide unbiased child care referrals that meet a family's specific needs
- 3. Send appropriate educational and follow-up materials to parents
- 4. Conduct marketing activities to make the community aware of the Child Care Search service
- 5. Enter accurate data into a computer database of clients, child care providers and community services
- 6. Contact child care providers and community partners to obtain updated information
- 7. Maintain confidentiality of information
- 8. Participate in agency staff meetings and community events and needed and available.
- 9. Other duties as required by funder or as assigned.

- Knowledgeable about child care, child development and early education
- Excellent customer service skills
- Good word processing and written communication skills
- Computer proficient and able to successfully navigate a web-based database
- Able to provide non-judgmental and unbiased counseling about child care
- Able to communicate respectfully and effectively with callers of diverse needs and backgrounds
- Four year degree in early childhood education or a related field (or an equivalent combination of
 education and experience) plus experience in child care, family support, social work, child
 development or a related field
